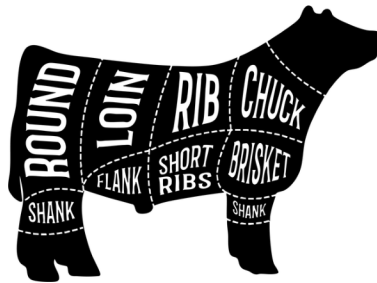
INVESTING IN LARAMIE COUNTY'S FUTURE

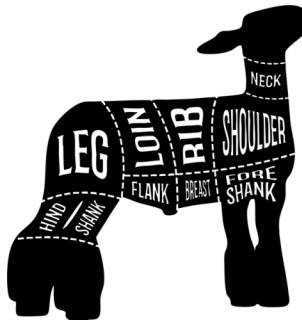

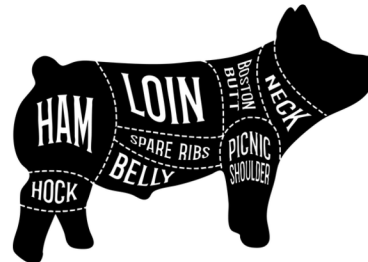
