

Kid's Casting Competition Rules and Regulations

OBJECTIVE

The objective of the contest is to cast as close as possible to the target. Every contestant has an equal chance to win.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CONTEST REGULATIONS

Any entrant failing to comply with any of the requirements as herein set forth shall be disqualified from the contest and will be ineligible to compete.

CONTESTANT CONDUCT

All contestants must adhere to the rules and regulations of the contest. Any contestants who harass the announcer, calling officials, scorekeepers, or other contestants will be disqualified immediately. This includes any family member even if they are not competing.

DIVISIONS

There are three divisions:

- 1. 0-6 years old
- 2. 7-12 years old
- 3. 13-15 years old

Contest officials reserve the right to reclassify contestants for the appropriate division.

REGISTRATION

All contestants are required to register prior to the competition. Registration will open 30 minutes before the beginning of the competition and close 5 minutes before the beginning of the competition. There is no registration fee. The competition is open to any qualifying persons. Contestants may only enter once per day.

COMPETITION FORMAT

Each division competition will be conducted in one round. Upon registration, contestants will be given a number. Contestants will be then be called up by number. Contestants will stand in the designated casting area and use the provided fishing rod to cast at the target. Contestants in the 0-6 age group will cast at a target 25' away. Contestants in the 7-12 age group will cast at a target 50' away. Contestants in the 13-15 age group will cast at a target 75' away. Contestants

are allowed a maximum of three (3) casts. There will be no recasts allowed. Contestants in the 0-6 age group are allowed to be helped by parents or guardians to a reasonable limit.

SCORING

Following each of three (3) casts, contest officials will place a marker at the final location of the bobber. Bounces or skips will not be scored; only the final location of the bobber will be scored. The distance between the marker and the target will be measured following the conclusion of each contestant's casts. Contest officials have the final call on all measurements.

TIES

All ties determining prize winners will be broken by a cast-off on Sunday. Contestants will be contacted if they need to return for a cast-off. In the event that a contestant is unable to return, they will forfeit their chance to earn a prize.

WINNERS

The contestant with the lowest final measurement, or in other words, the contestant closest to the target in each division will be determined the winner.
